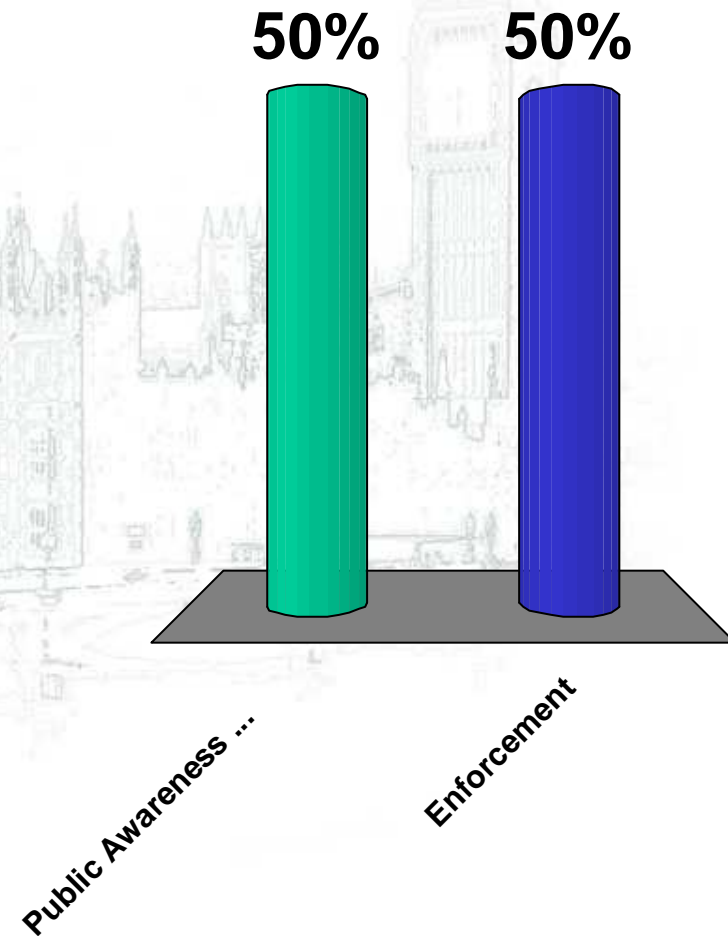

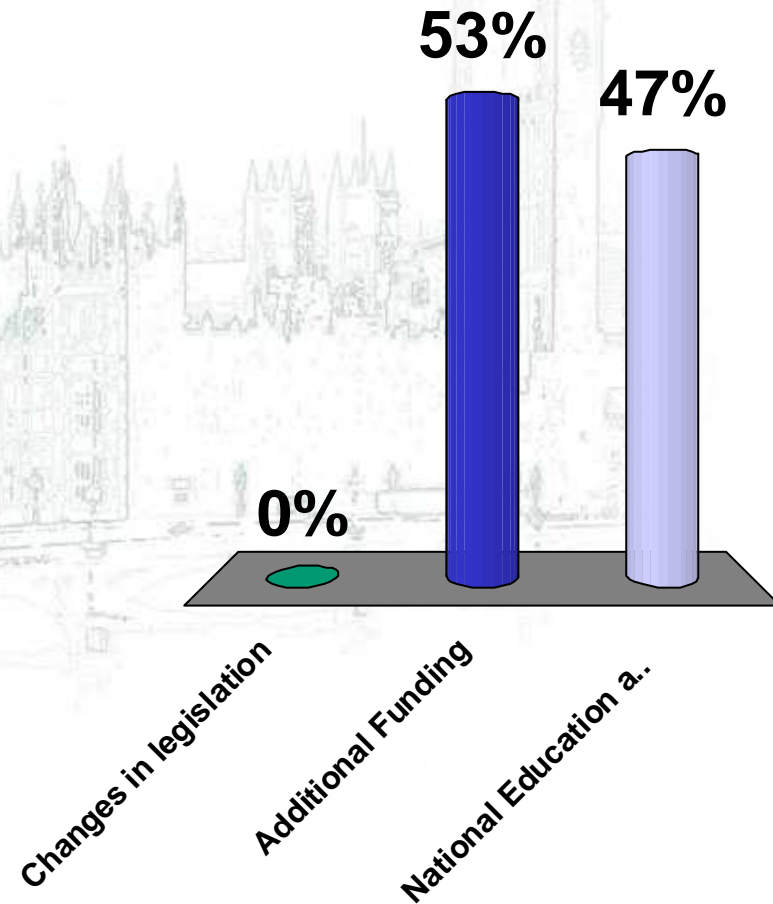
Thinking about your local situation, which do you think has most beneficial impact?

2. Enforcement



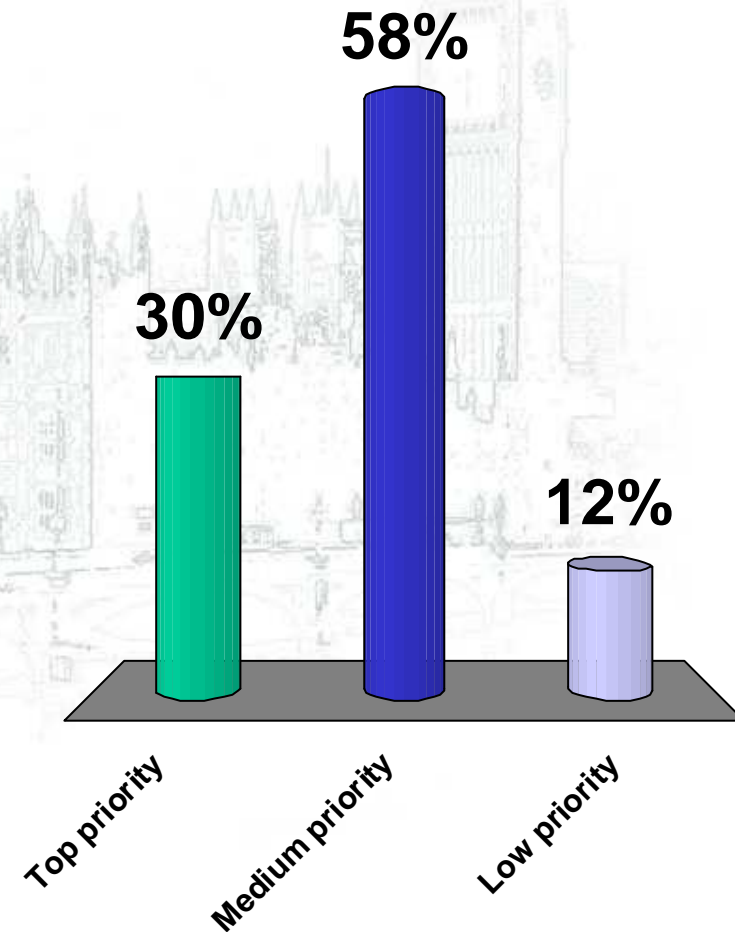
What single measure would enable you to improve the local environment and street scene?

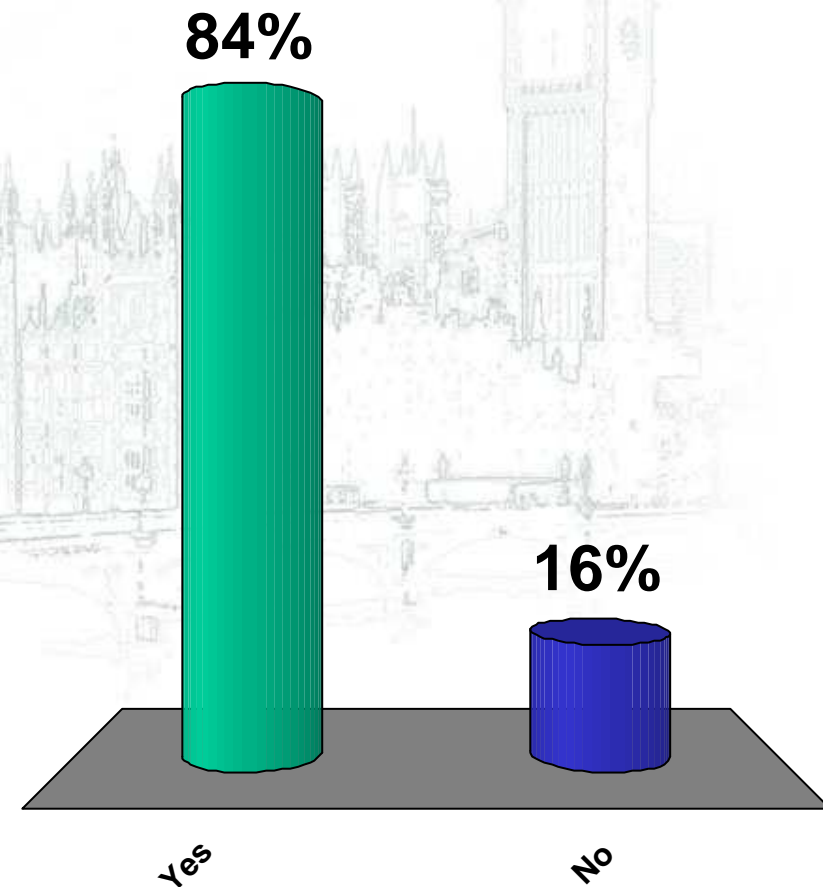
Do you think, for your councillors in your local authority, that reducing littering and environmental crime is:

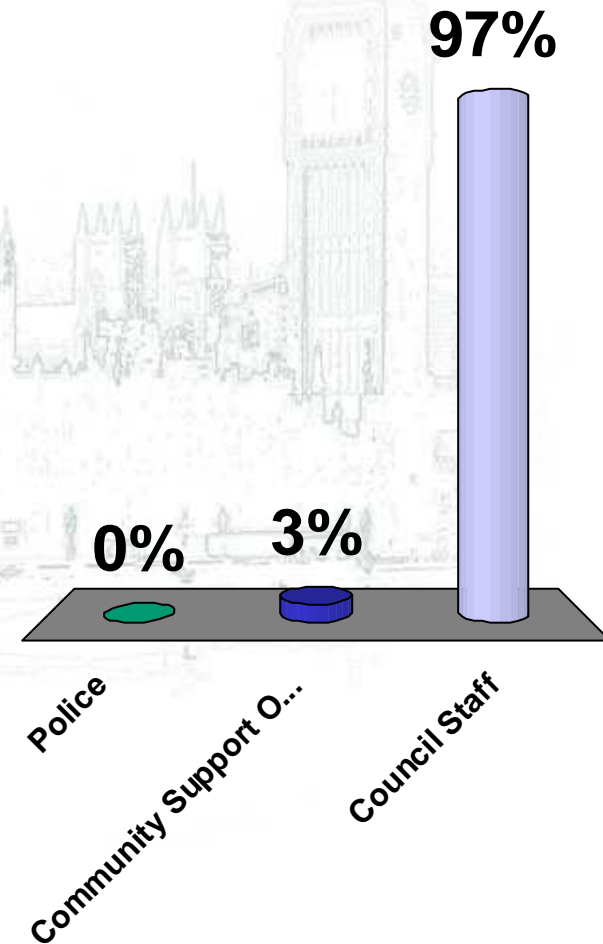

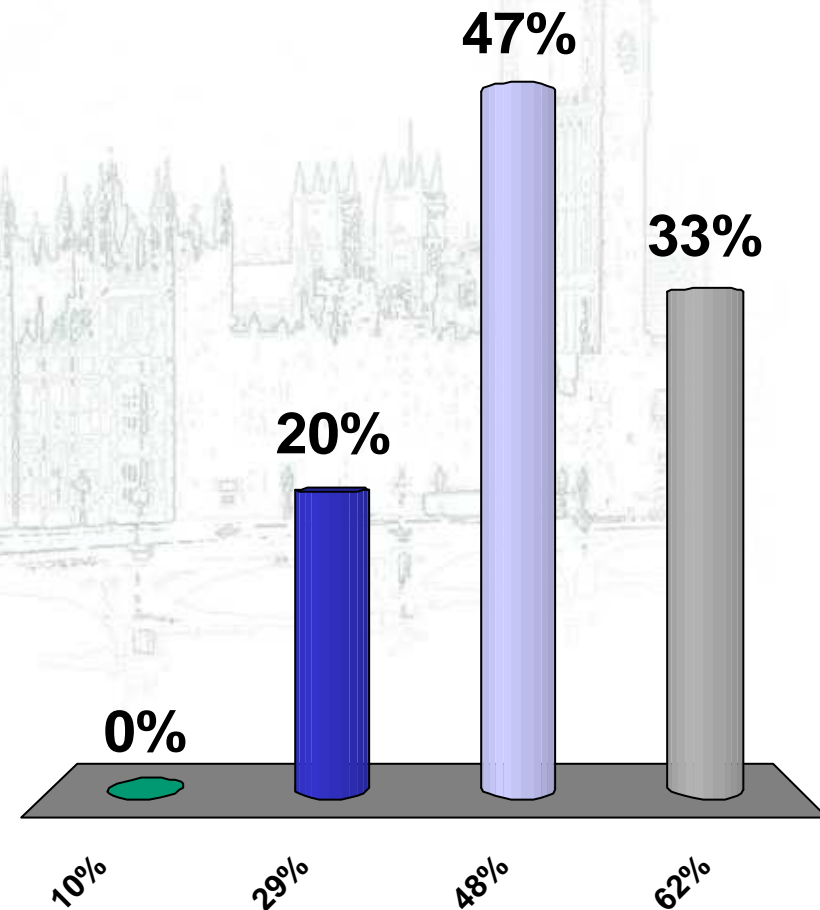
