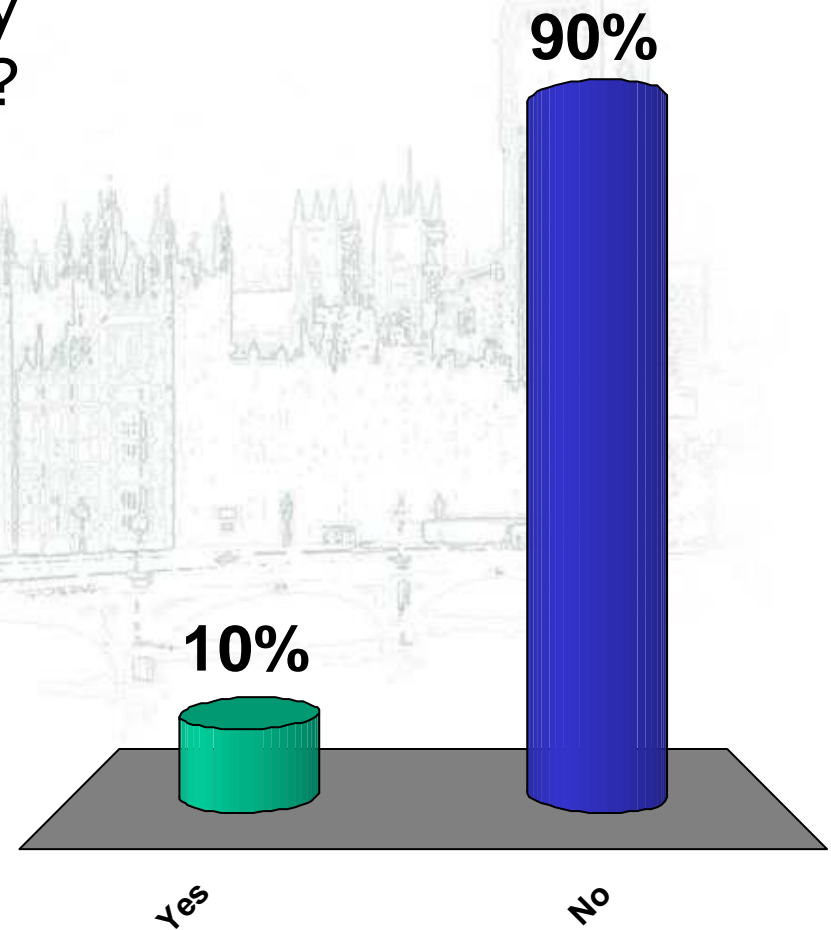

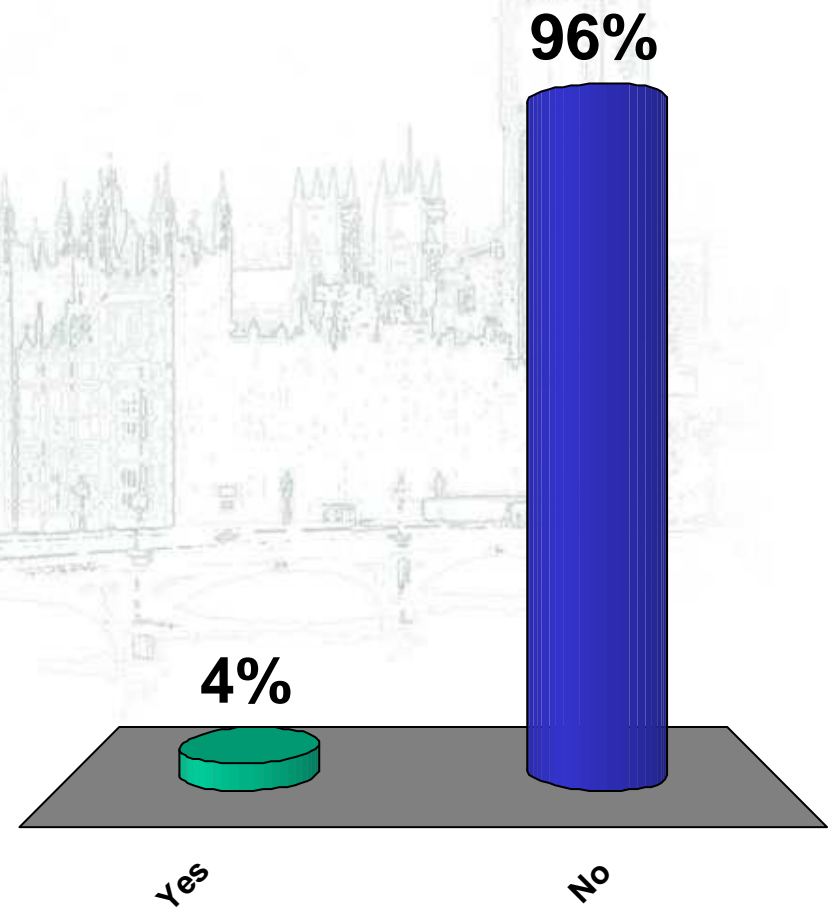
Are adequate resources and funds being allocated for sexual health, and are they reaching frontline services?

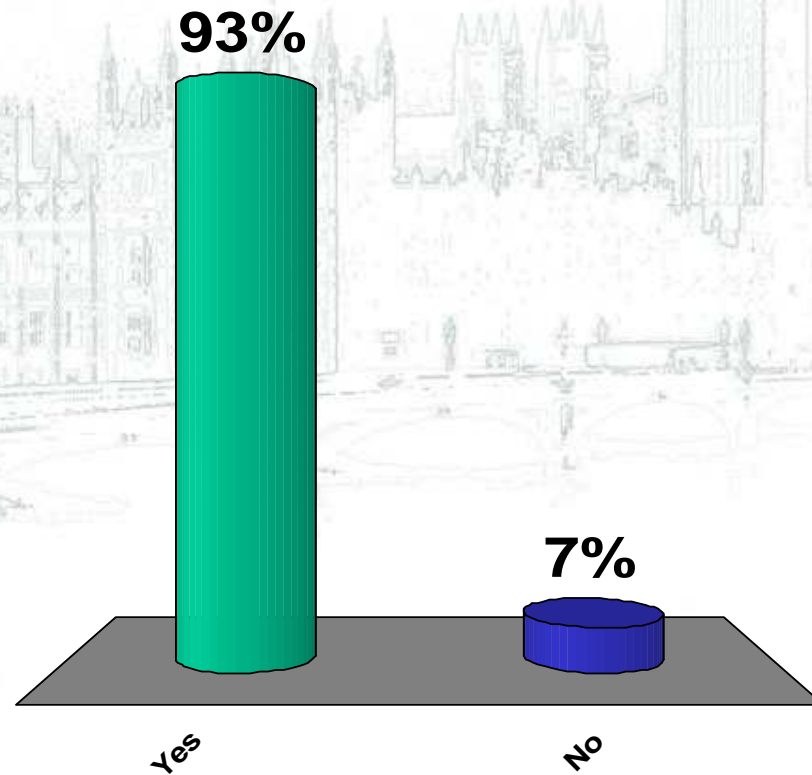

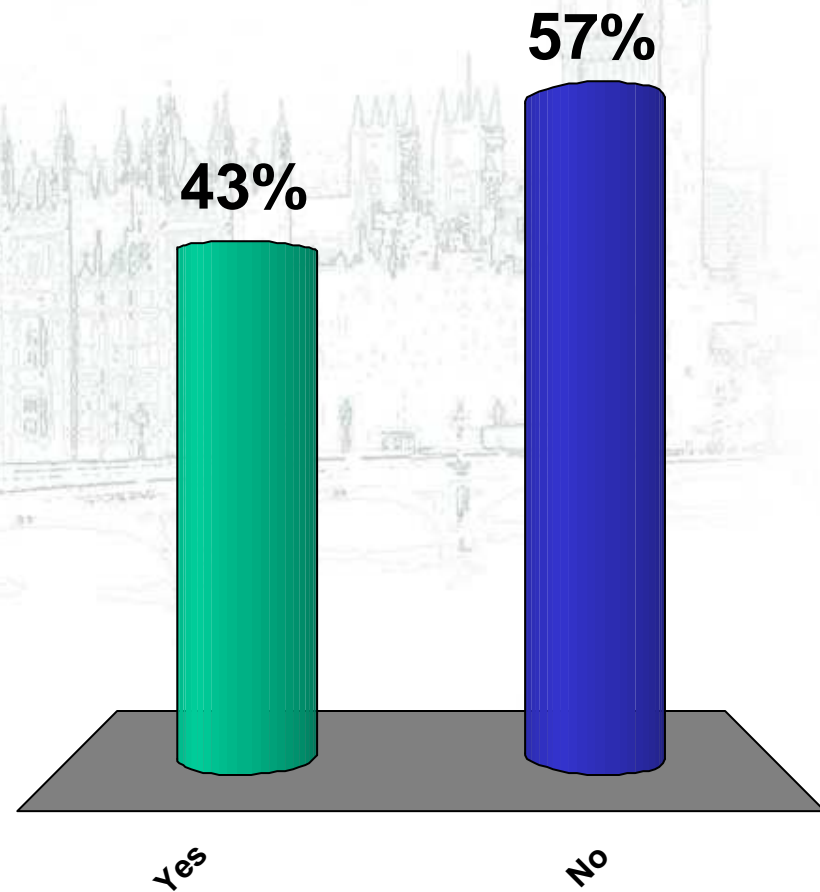

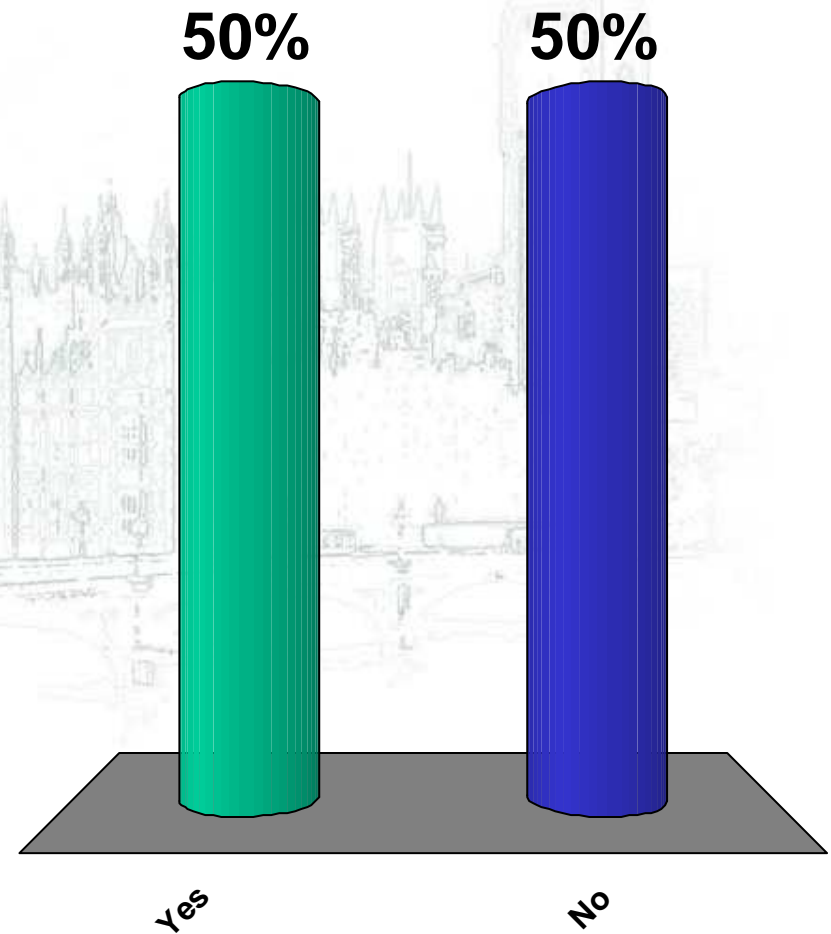
