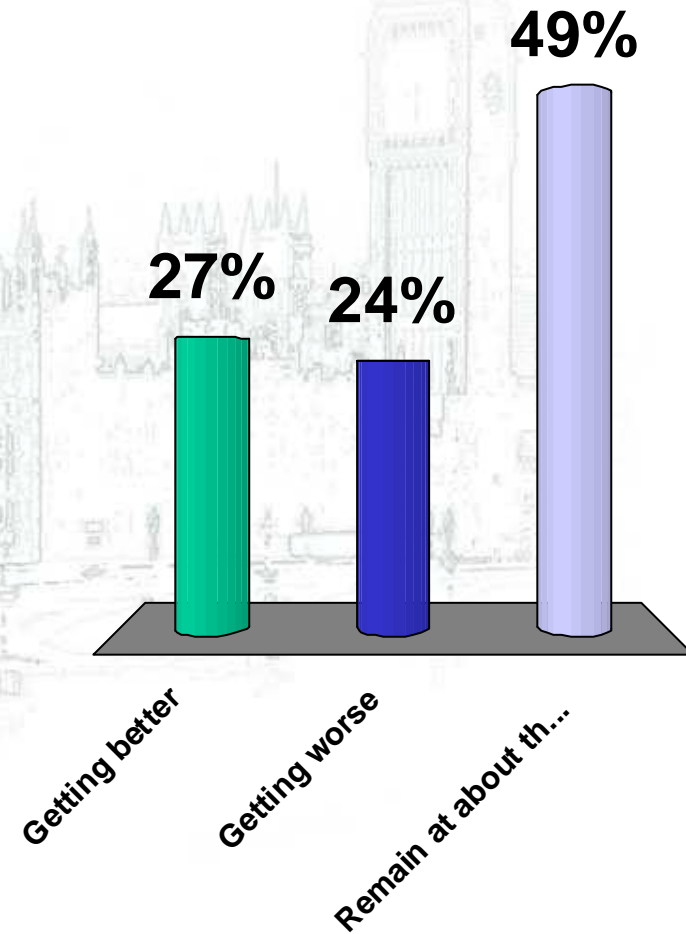

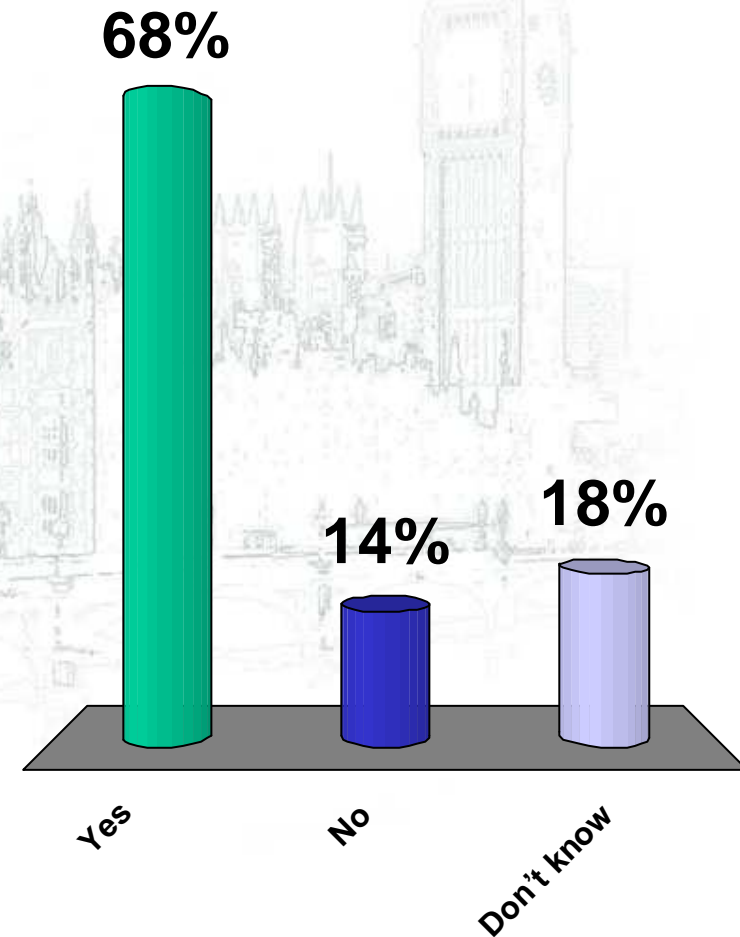
Based on your personal experiences, are problems surrounding drugs in this country getting better or worse?

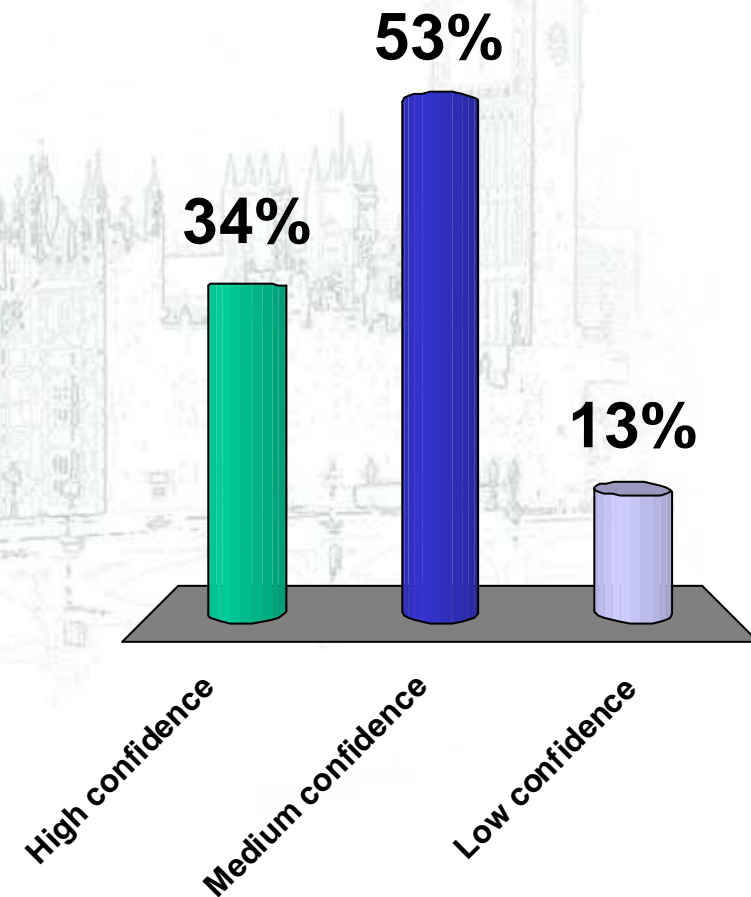
Do you think the new 10-year drug strategy “Drugs: protecting families and communities” sets the right priorities ?

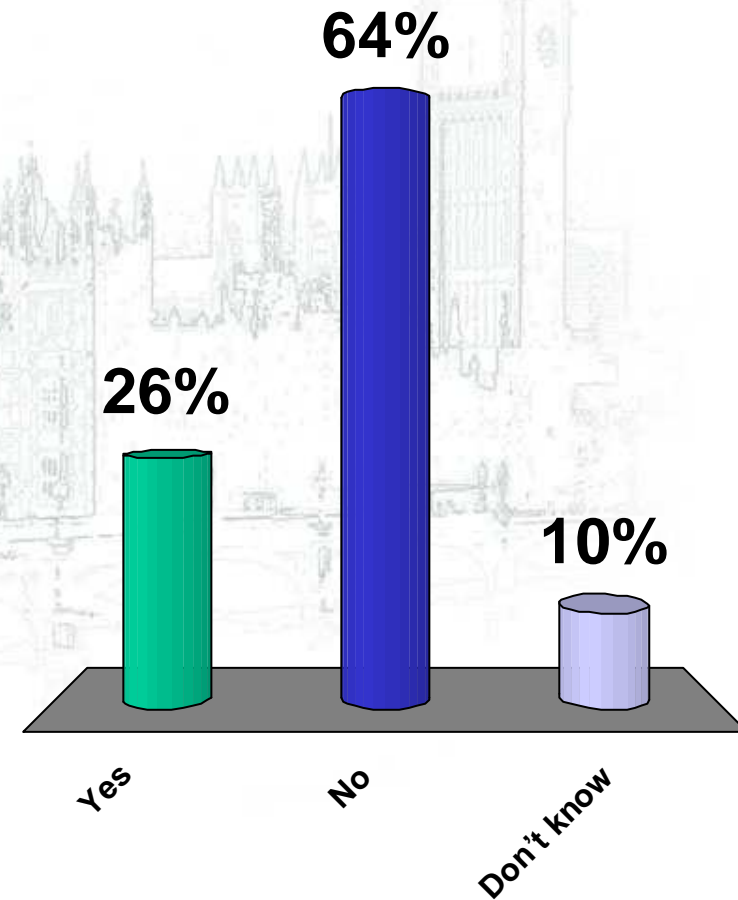
Looking at the new strategy and the action plan, how confident do you feel that you will be able to deliver within your area/professional disciplines?

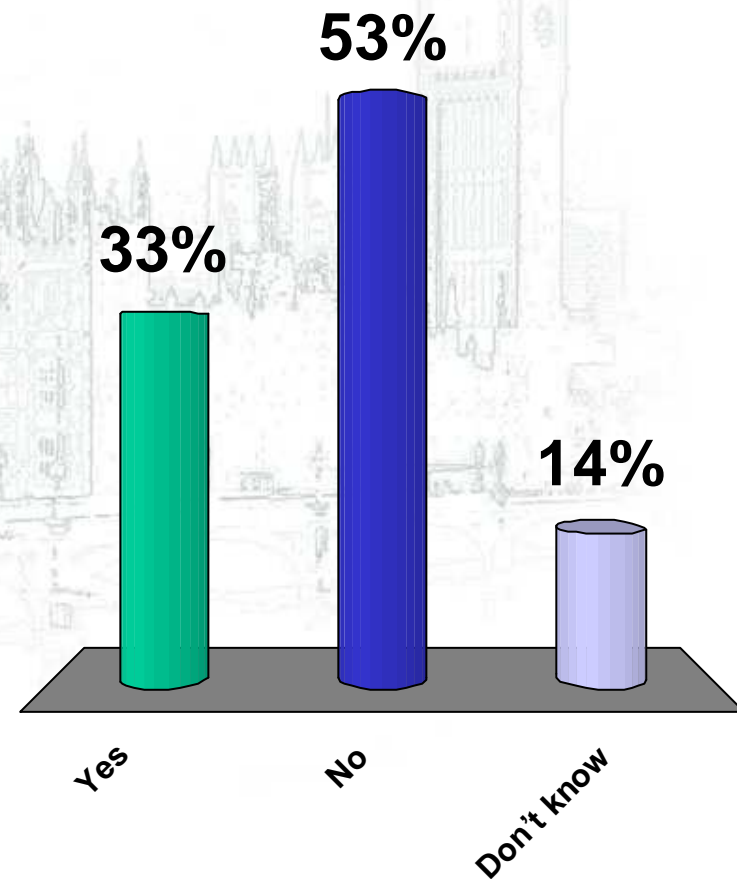

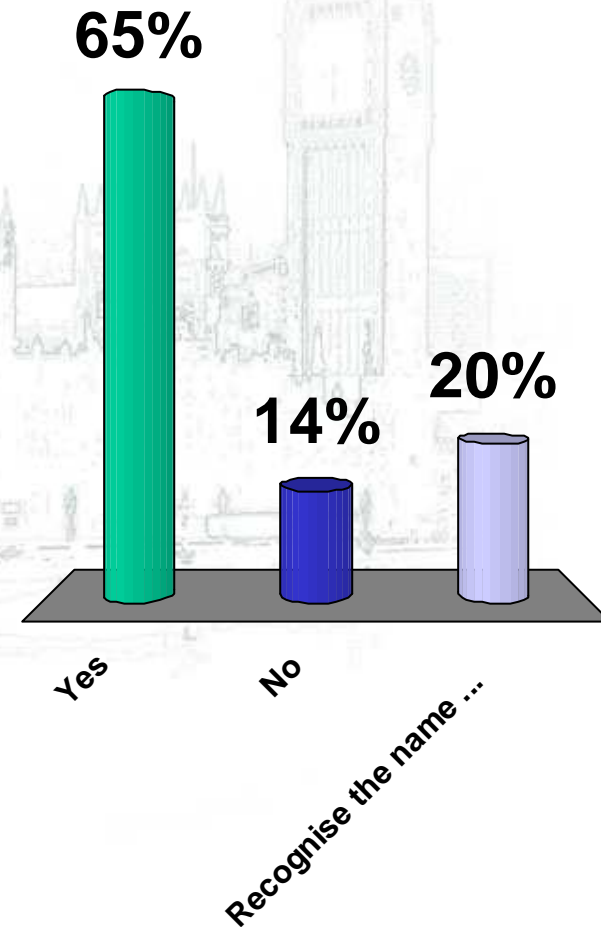

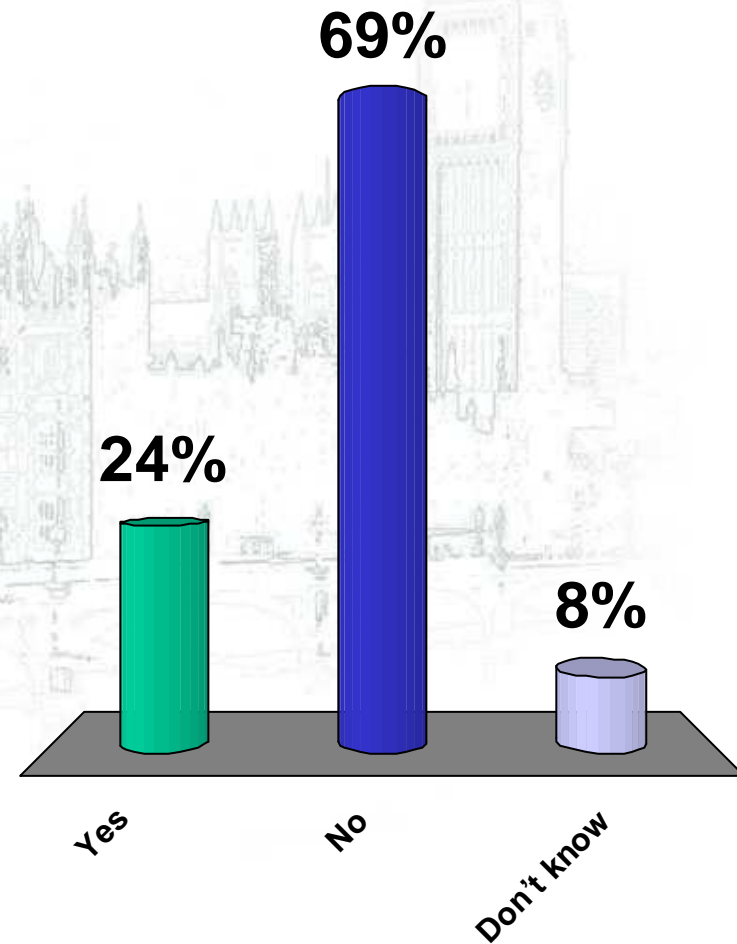

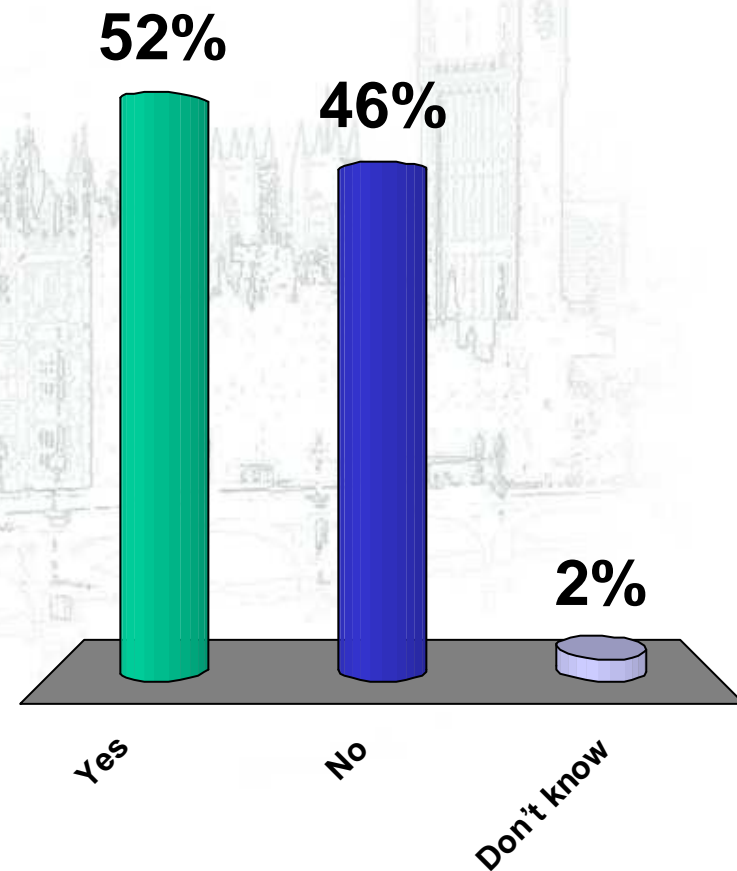
