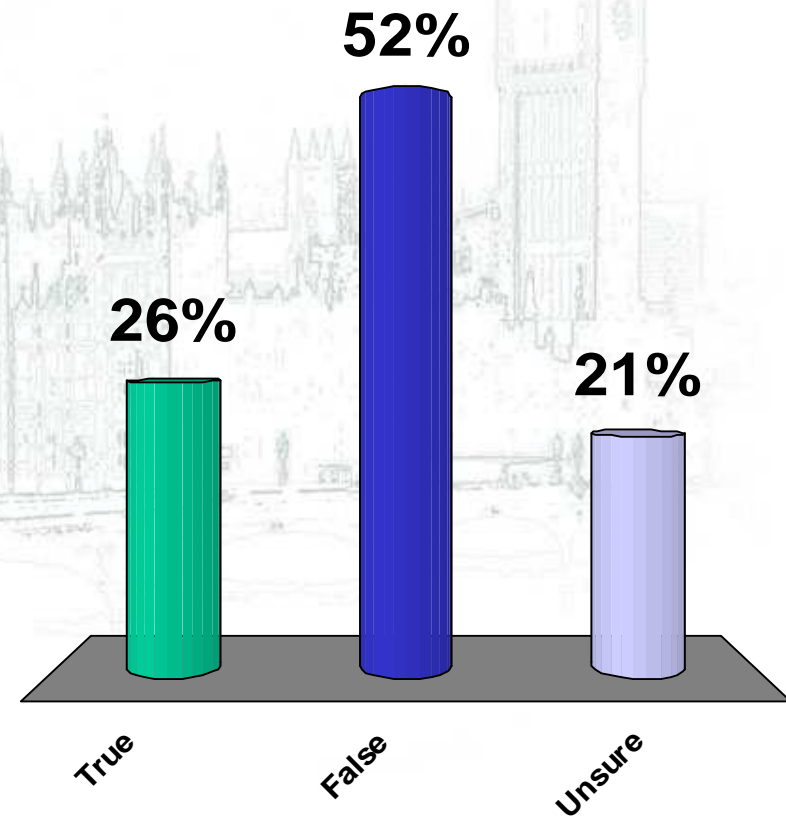

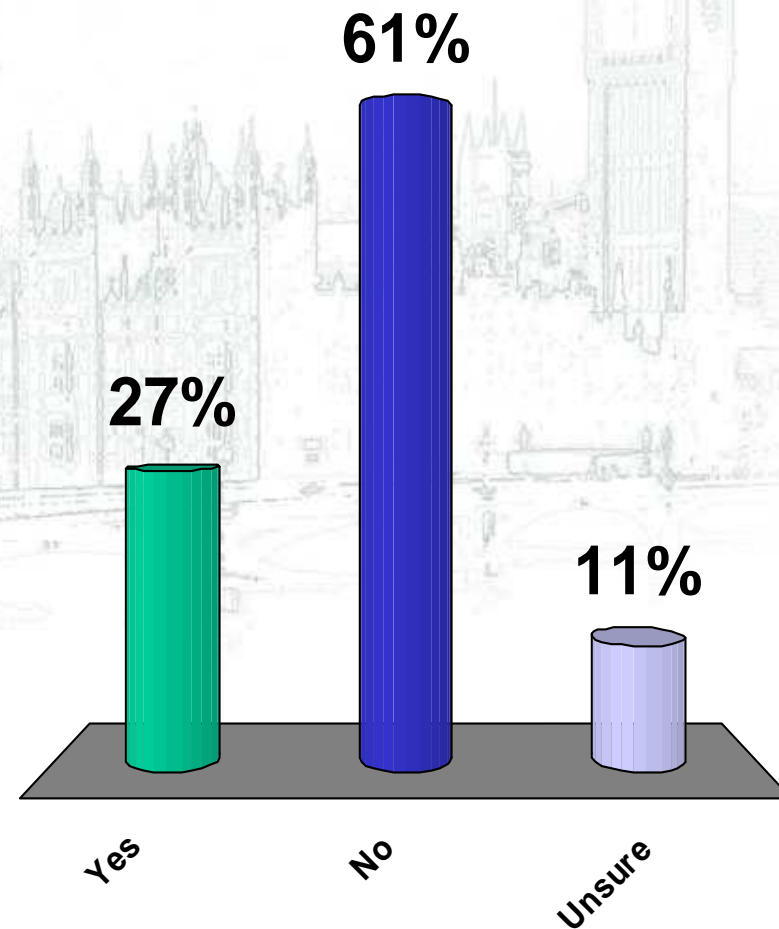

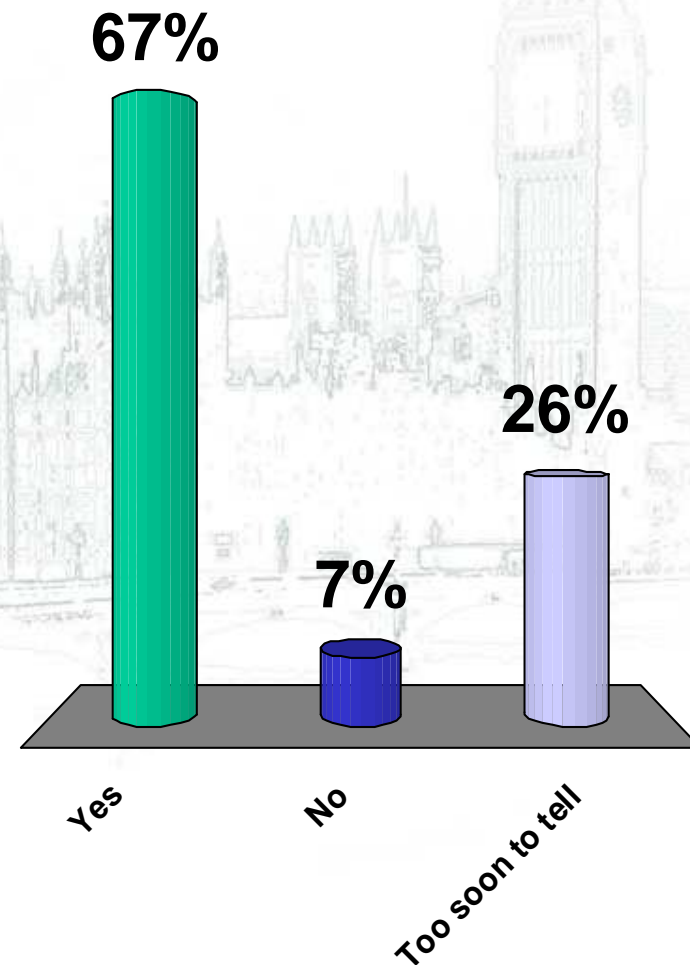
Whilst life expectancy has increased, do you think this is just added years of low quality health :-

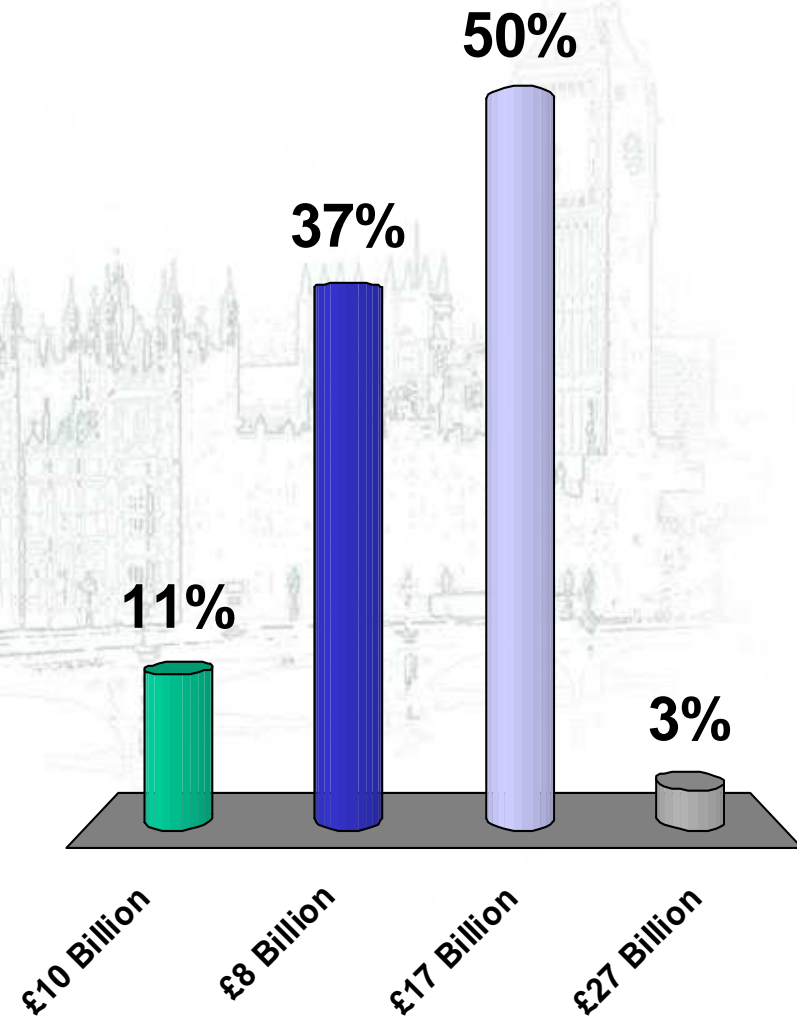
Do you agree with the government's push to move resources from acute to preventative services?

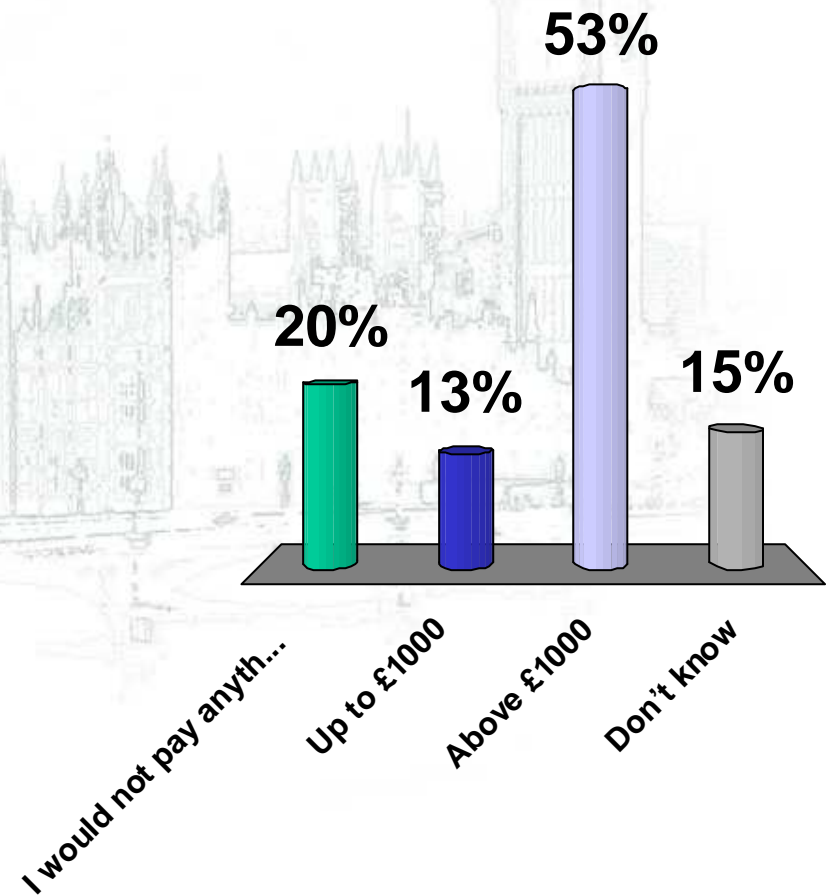
Do you know how much is currently spent on dementia services in the UK?
