


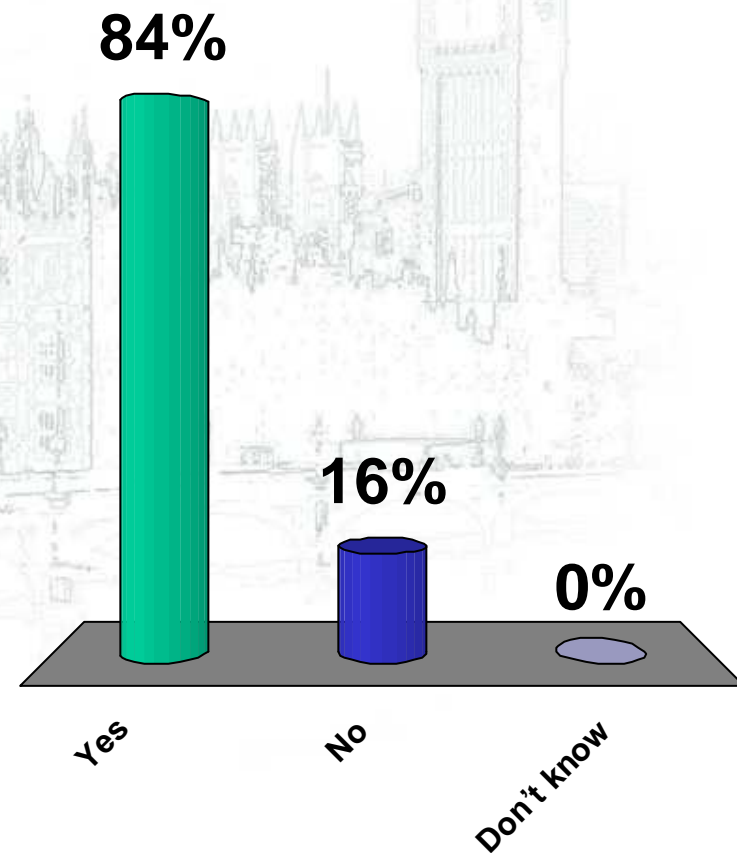

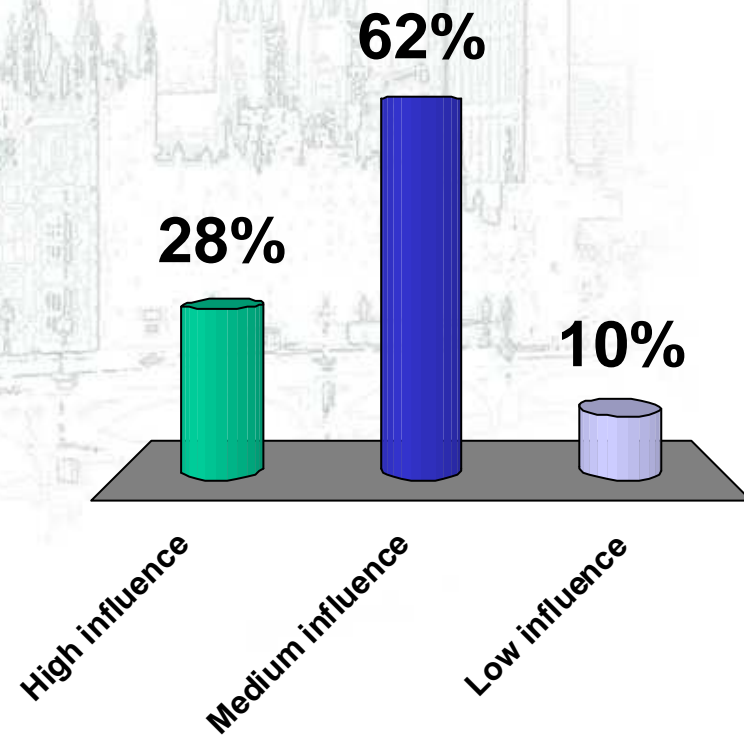
Has press coverage of

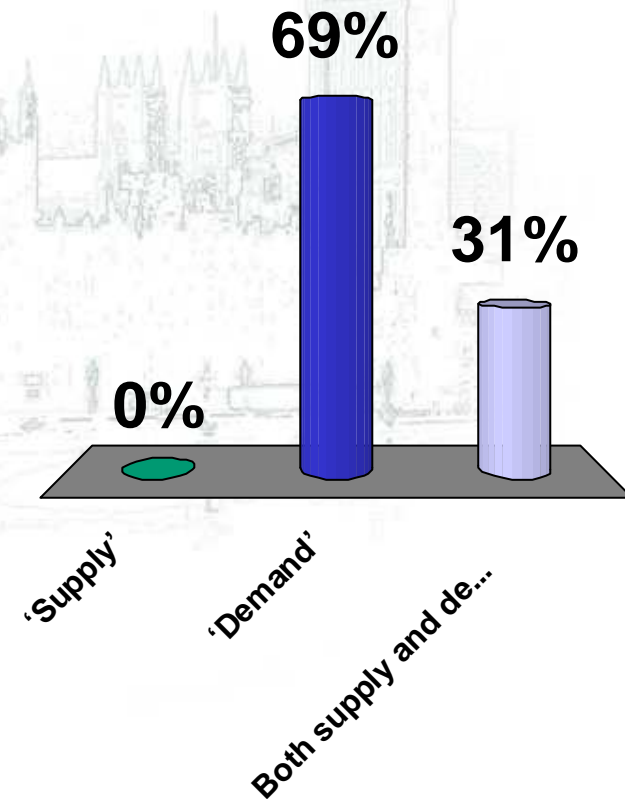
The Coordinated Prostitution Strategy has had what level of influence over your work:

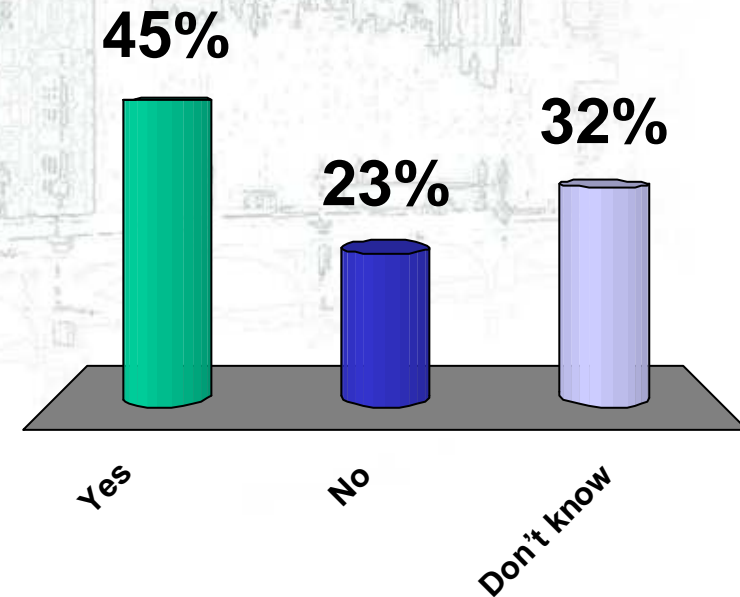

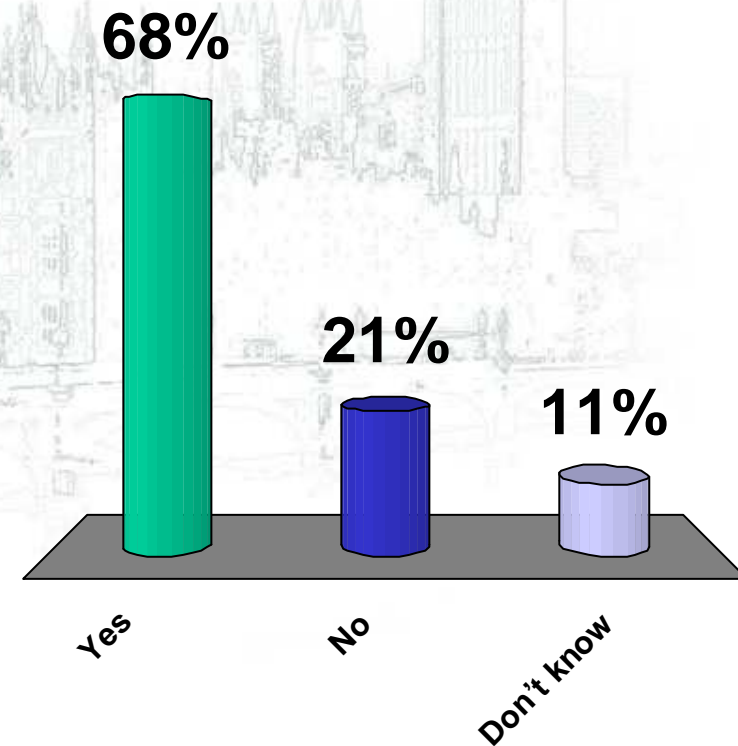

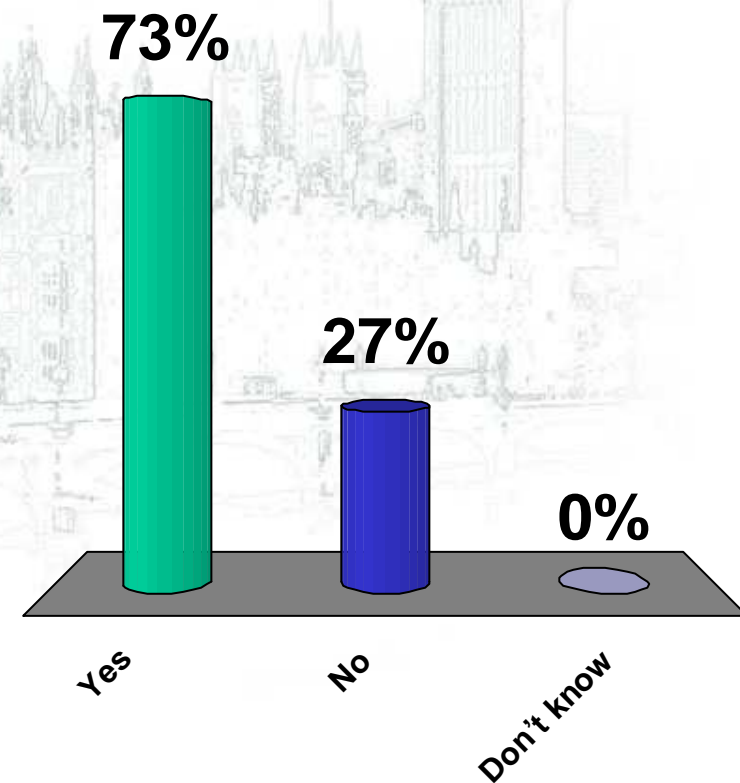

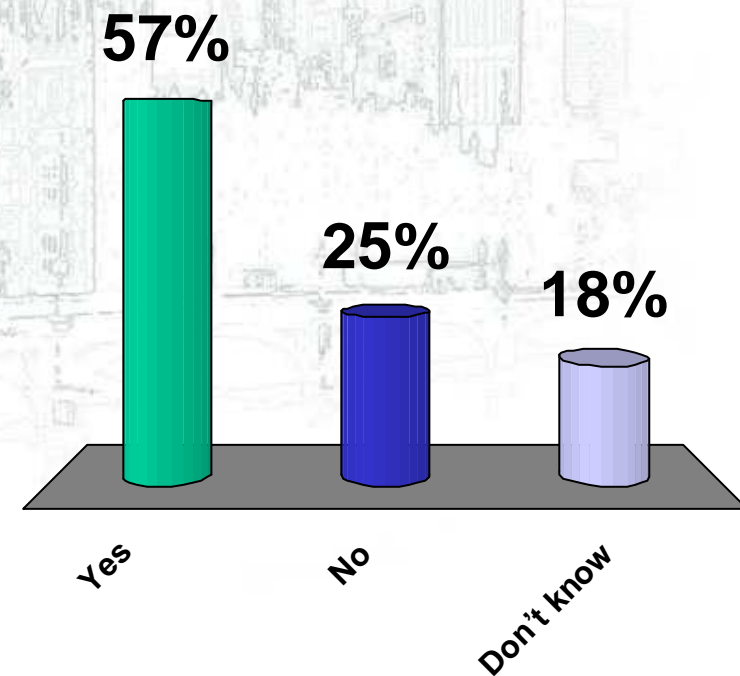
